Distance is no barrier in proving Survival

'DEAD' HUSBAND SPANS 12,000 MILES TO CONVINCE HIS SCEPTICAL WIFE

Evidence at proxy seances is 'absolutely fantastic'

MEDIUMSHIP'S unique value is proved when a sceptical widow gets "absolutely fantastic" Survival evidence from her "dead" husband. This New Zealand woman tells PN that two taped, one-hour proxy sittings by London medium Ronald Hearn, 12,000 miles away, have given her "a completely new outlook on life."

Her husband furnishes details of which he had no knowledge when his passing came in "a very nasty car accident."

Adele Jackson of Kopara Street, Christchurch, wrote to Hearn—he specialises in proxy sittings—after reading of his success with another Christchurch resident.

This was Ken Holland, 17, who made front-page news in PN 15 months ago with his spirit return through Hearn. Killed outright in a dreadful motorcycle smash, he returned to his parents with irrefutable Survival evidence only weeks later.

Hearn's mediumship has "completely convinced" Adele of an after-life.

'Previously I was very dubious'

"The messages on the tapes could definitely not have come from anyone but my husband Bruce," she says.

"Yet before receiving the first message I was very dubious."

At the time of his tragic passing she was expecting her third child, a fact Bruce did not know. Through Hearn he says "there was going to be a boy born into the family. Our third child was a boy."

Bruce thanks his wife for "smoothing his brow." Adele says that when his physical body lay in the coffin, she kissed his forehead.

Bruce tells the medium he was "killed in a very nasty car accident," adding that Adele has his watch and wallet. The police gave these to her after the crash.

Hearn relays the husband's accurate description of the wallet, which is damaged "in one corner" and gives details of the emblem engraved on the front. The wallet's contents are also correctly listed.

Description called astounding

The medium is bang on target about Bruce's physical body.

The medium astounds Adele with the details of Bruce's erect stature, brown, magnetic eyes, a nose peculiarity ("this was due to being a boxer earlier in life") and a teeth defect. Adele says her husband had a gap between his top front teeth.

Next he mentions a scar on Bruce's abdomen, adding it is "perhaps a burn." Adele confirms this and explains a joke about her husband's hair.

Hearn says, "A little can look a lot." Comments Adele: "Bruce was very conscious of the fact he was thinning on top. His hair was always brushed back, as

Hearn describes it, and the medium is right about his high forehead."

Her husband begs her not to worry about his grave, "which I had been doing," Adele admits. Bruce says "he is not really dead. This I truly believe."

Pointing forefinger habit confirmed

Another bull's eye is the statement that Bruce pointed his forefinger. "This he frequently did," says the wife, "especially when trying to make his point known on some subject."

A correct reference to a farm where the couple used to live is followed by the mention of a cap which Bruce "used to wear only for work. This was also described, and that I hated sewing buttons on it."

The medium talks of billiards. "Bruce played a few games of this the night before the accident."

Hearn says that during one communication, he feels Bruce is hopping. "This was something he often did due to cramp."

Adele adds: "Bruce says there is something in my new home which I am always forgetting to wind. This is undoubtedly the watch I've had for over 20 years. I am always asking other people the time."

Bruce shows his knowledge of Adele's new home. He gives details, "like the front door

being very hard to open, the wardrobe door in my bedroom squeaking and that I've recently been having trouble with linoleum in the house.

"In the bathroom the lino was turning up at the edges. I became perturbed and tacked it all down."

Bruce shows his continued nearness to the family in several references. Hearn says the husband laughs about pyjamas.

"This makes me feel as if he is really close to us," comments Adele. "Only a few weeks back, we were having a hilarious time at the breakfast table about a pair of pyjamas."

Mention is made of teasing about pillows. "We were always joking about whose pillow was whose," Adele explains.

Bruce correctly describes his children, Peter, nine, Sonya, five, and Michael, three, "right down to the last detail."

The husband correctly recalls a birthmark on Sonya—which he places "exactly"—and warns

Michael "to watch out for his legs. Only a week before he fell from a roof and hurt one badly."

"My husband also saw a Mickey Mouse being drawn. This is correct. I had just done one on Sonya's new school bag. She had just started school and so many bags are the same."

Bruce talks of an elbow condition affecting Adele. "Only a few months ago, I had it X-rayed." A small bone chip was found "floating about."

Adele points out these evidential details are only a few given in her husband's messages. She ends:

"I cannot possibly tell you all I feel about this new experience. I had never explored the psychic field previously."

"I have a completely new outlook on life. I would like to thank Ronald Hearn from the bottom of my heart for all the comfort and serenity he has brought me—and thank PN for making it all possible."
