'Dead' pop star returns to manager HE CONFIRMS MARC BOLAN'S SEANCE PROOFS

POP star Marc Bolan, who was killed in a car crash three years ago, has returned to his road manager Mick O'Halloran, with cast-iron Survival evidence, PN heard last week.

Among the details came a reference to a new song which a third party confirmed. Thus telepathy is ruled out.

Mention of a wig, white swan and almost being electrocuted all helped to prove Bolan's identity.

Through medium Ronald Hearn, Bolan sent a message to his fans that he is still "very much alive." He wanted to thank admirers for their support and loyalty.

Healers get results

The report came from Spiritualist Peter Ingold, who met the manager when he attended a demonstration by Hearn on the Isle of Wight.

"Mick told me his remarkable story during an impromptu interview," said Peter. His account has its roots in a TV series Bolan had in Manchester, for Granada. "We did the first two of five programmes," said Mick, "and came home for a break. I went out in my boat and had a stroke."

Mick, in hospital for six weeks, underwent two operations. Doctors said he had "a 50-50 chance of being a cabbage. Thank God I got over it."

"During that time Marc was killed in a road accident." After surgery Mick was told it would be two years before medics could assess whether or not he would ever walk again. His left side was paralysed.

Soon after he was introduced to spirit healers Isobel Thompson and Den Clare.

"When I began getting movement in my left side, I went to Isobel regularly for treatment," said Mick.

Now he walks unaided. Only when pains return to his left leg, the bad one, does he need to use a stick.

The manager was singled out for a message from Hearn at a Ventnor Spiritualist church meeting in April. Isobel took Mick with her to witness Ronald's mediumship.

Hearn said Bolan was talking about a white swan. The singer had a hit record of this name.

Mick thought that was the end of the communication's relevance. But it concealed further evidence. His son remembered that for Bolan's funeral service, a record company sent flowers shaped like a white swan.

Hearn relayed the message that Mick's wife would be going away, but he was not to worry. Good would come of the trip.

"Sure enough, my wife did," said Mick. "Unexpectedly, though she rarely leaves me, she went to see her mother for a few days."

"Good did come from it because a friend was instrumental in my getting an old piano."

"I had the urge to try to play it with my left hand." This was once quite lifeless. Mick bent his fingers and clenched his hand to show the dramatic mobility improvement which came from exercising his fingers on the keys.

Stance is test

When Hearn demonstrated in Ryde on July 17, Isobel Thompson and Mick again attended.

"Ronald gave two or three messages, then out of the blue came to me," he said.

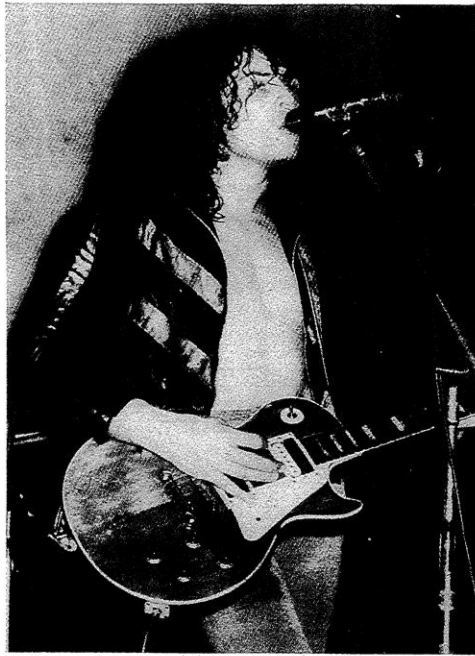
The medium explained, "I've a young man here who stands like this." Hearn made a most unusual stance.

"He stood exactly the same way Marc did," said Mick. "After finishing a recording session that is exactly how he stood to listen to the playbacks."

"Only those present would know how he stood."

This convinced the manager it was Bolan communicating. "If you could have taken Ronald's head and put Marc's in its place, you would have sworn it was Bolan standing there."

Hearn correctly said that before

his passing, Bolan had promised to help Mick.

A few weeks later, Mick received a taped sitting from Hearn. This medium specialises in recording proxy seances. The evidence included a full description of Marc's personality and told in detail how Bolan threw down his guitar and kept patting his bottom.

Mick confirmed this and told Peter, "Hearn gave a very good description of him."

Marc reminded Mick of a joke linked with a wig. "We were in America," said the manager. "Marc's wife and I went into a store where she bought a huge, brilliant, pink wig."

"She asked me to wear it on the way back to the hotel. I walked in wearing it. Marc fell about laughing."

Bolan recalled on the tape how twice he was nearly electrocuted. In Japan Marc's guitar had no earth wire. When he switched on the instrument it lit up like an electric fire.

The second occasion was in Canada. "One of the lighting towers nearly came down on him," Mick explained. "We had to try and hold it up." Both accidents were nearly fatal.

On the tape Marc said Mick would be in contact with people connected with him.

"A week or two after receiving the sitting, a Marc Bolan disco party was held at Newport, Isle of Wight. Fans converged there from throughout Britain."

"It was an enormous success. One of Marc's greatest fans - she came from Wales - attended the meeting."

Mick played her the tape. "As far as she was concerned, it was Marc to a T." She was completely convinced he was communicating.

The fan confirmed one item of evidence which puzzled Mick. Hearn related a message that prior to his passing, Bolan was writing a new song.

The admirer "screamed with joy when she heard this. I'd told Hearn I did not know about it. There was no way of checking because I was then in hospital."

"The fan said: 'I can verify that. Mr Feld (Marc's father) told me that at the time of his son's death, the police brought a little tape recorder round. When they played it, they heard a new song Marc was writing.'"

Through Hearn Marc told Mick he still visits him. He accurately described seeing the manager at work in his garage.

The medium told how Mick

Marc Bolan talks from the grave

ROCK superstar Marc Bolan, who died three years ago in a car crash, has spoken from the grave, claims his former road manager.

Mick O'Halloran, who spent nine years with Bolan, contacted him through a medium.

Mick, 33, said: "It sounds fantastic but it's true. And I have no doubt he will try just to get through to me again."

"He wants his fans to know he is still very much alive and to thank them for their support and loyalty," Mick says. "Marc sent him a message via world famous medium Ronald Hearn, during a public demonstration near his home at Ryde, Isle of Wight."

TV He said: "The most impressive service direct from

credible thing was the stance adopted by Mr Hearn while Marc was communicating through it."

"It was exactly the way Marc used to stand on stage."

"It was so uncanny that you could have replaced Mr Hearn's head with one Marc's and it would have been him to a T."

"Mr Hearn told me of things which in no way could have been public knowledge."

"He spoke of one incident when I arrived in an American hotel wearing a huge pink wig and Marc fell about laughing."

"And he recalled two occasions when Marc narrowly missed being electrocuted and crushed to death."

"But the most conclusive evidence was the fact that Marc was writing a new song just before his death."

"I didn't know that. But when I mentioned it to a fan she said that Marc's father told her the police recovered a half-finished tape after his death. It was all quite uncanny. I am positive that it was Marc speaking through Mr Hearn."
